1 Aims and Objectives

- 2.5 Use safe and economic services for recycling, refuse collection, cleansing and waste disposal. Promote waste minimisation at all AECL sites including re-use, repair and recycling.
- 2.6 In conjunction with the Landlords to maximise energy efficiency in the design, maintenance and operation of AECL sites.

2.7 Review, mitigate and manage environmental impact in relation to the services provided to clients. This is undertaken within the framework of management reviews and the Environmental Action Plan.
